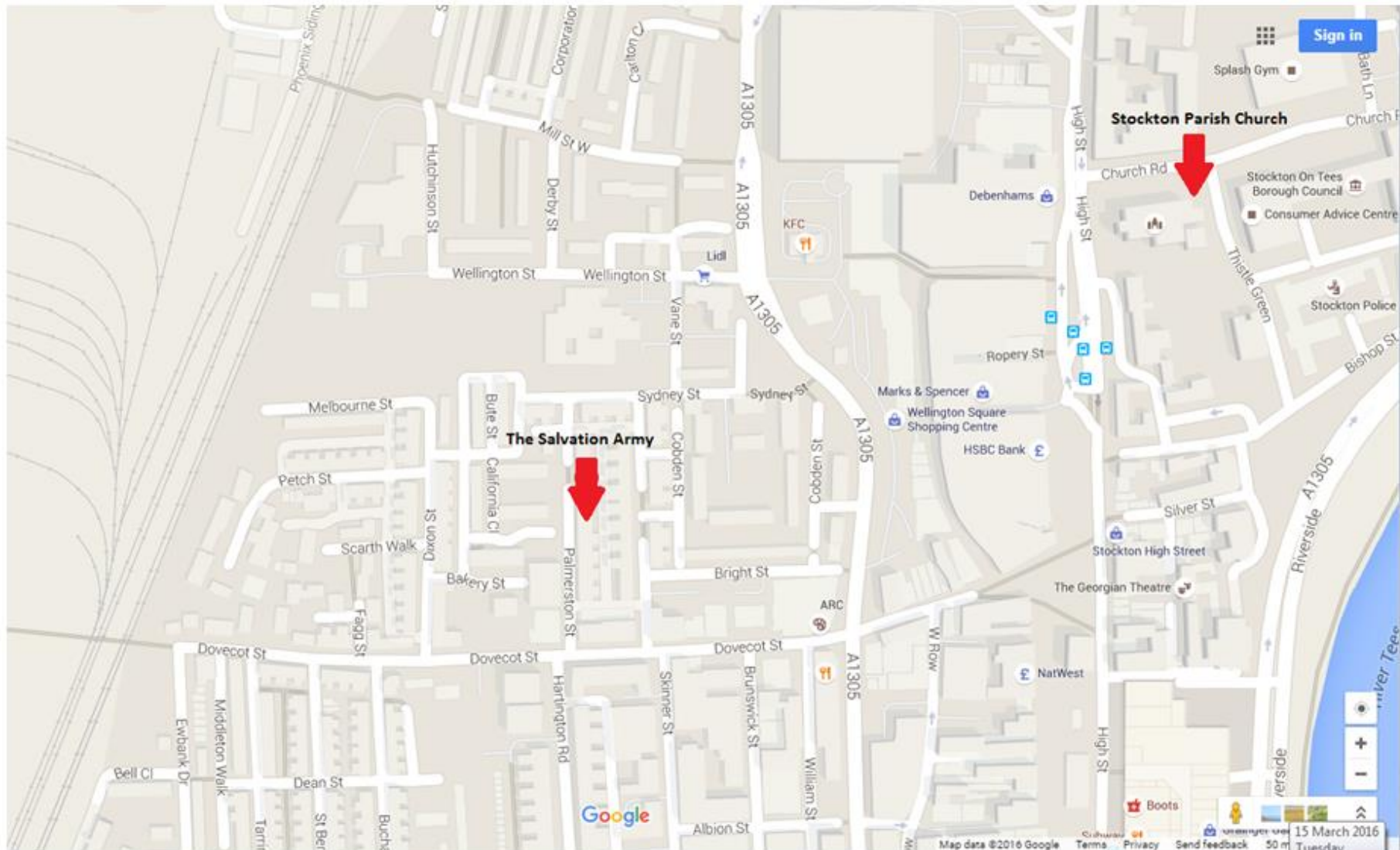

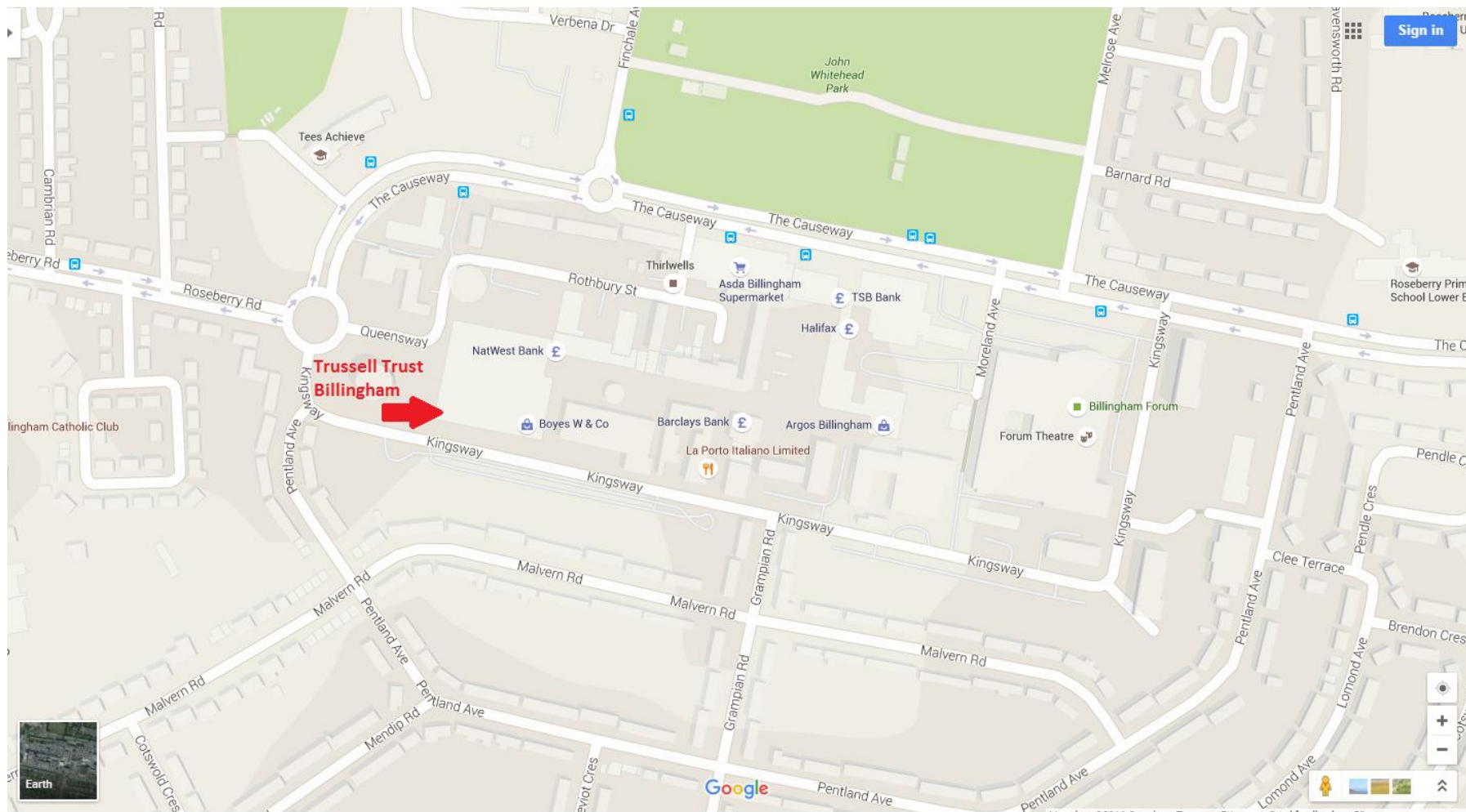

Stockton Town Centre



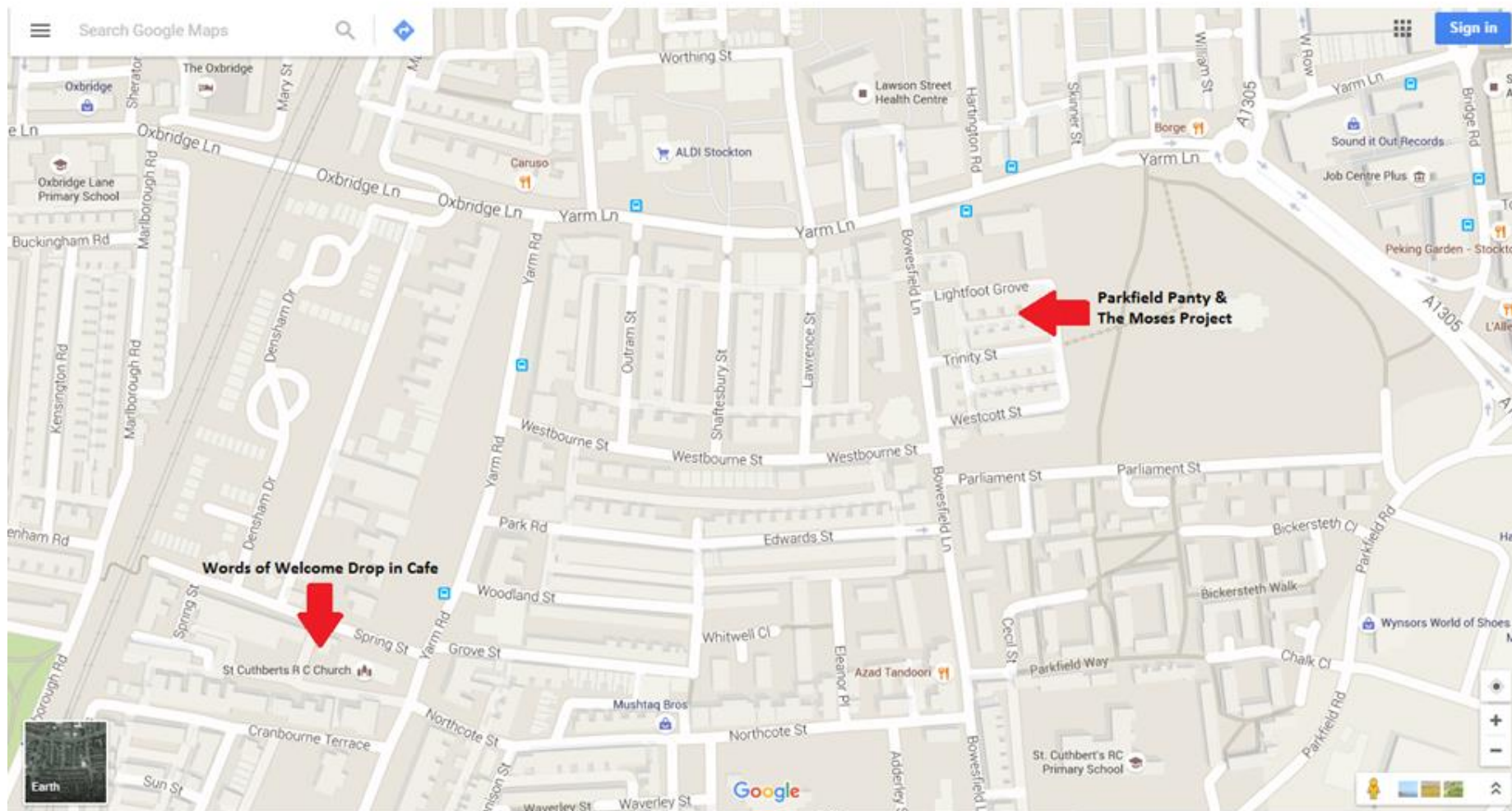

Billingham Central



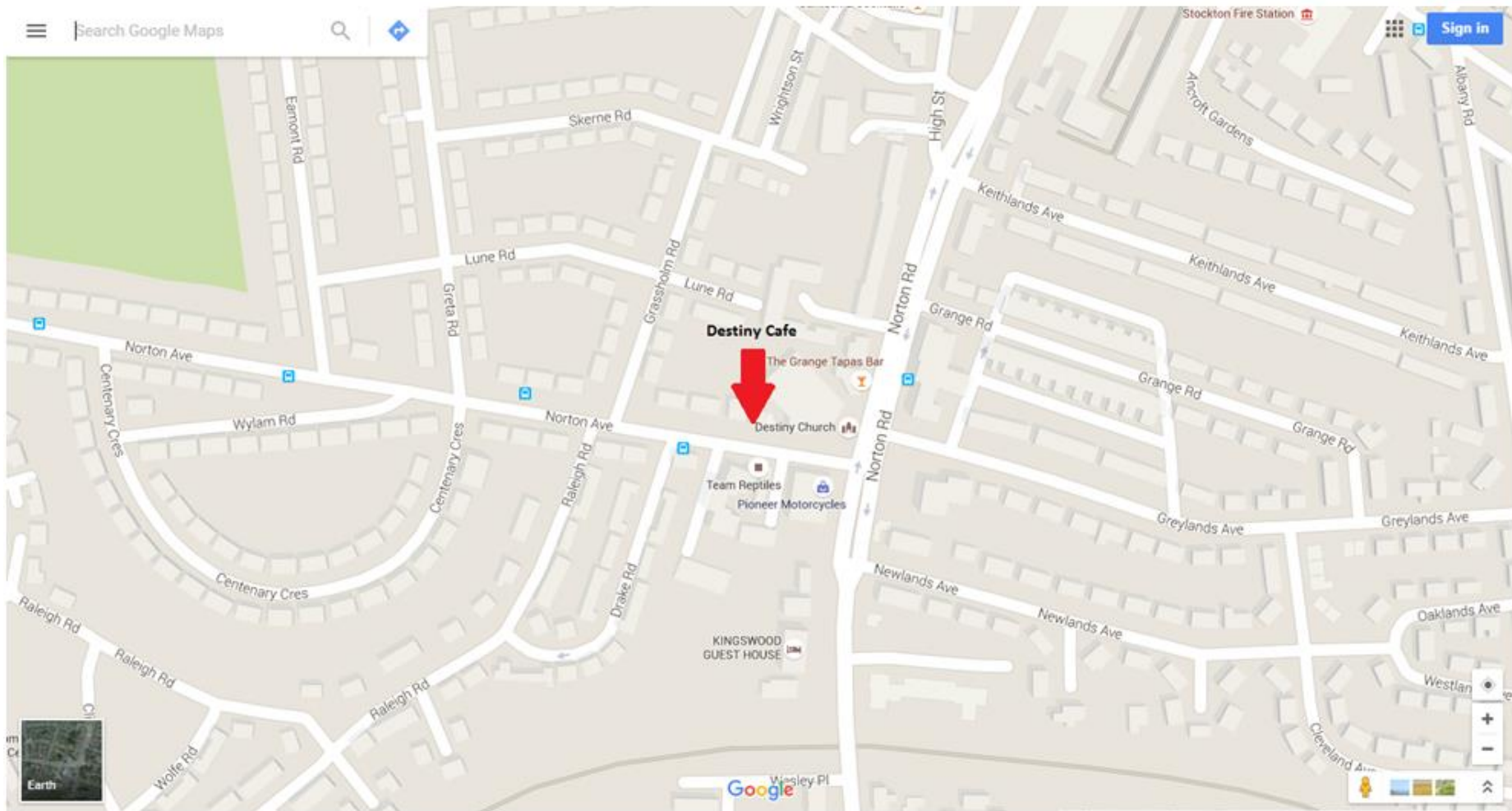

Stockton Town Centre & Parkfield And Oxbridge



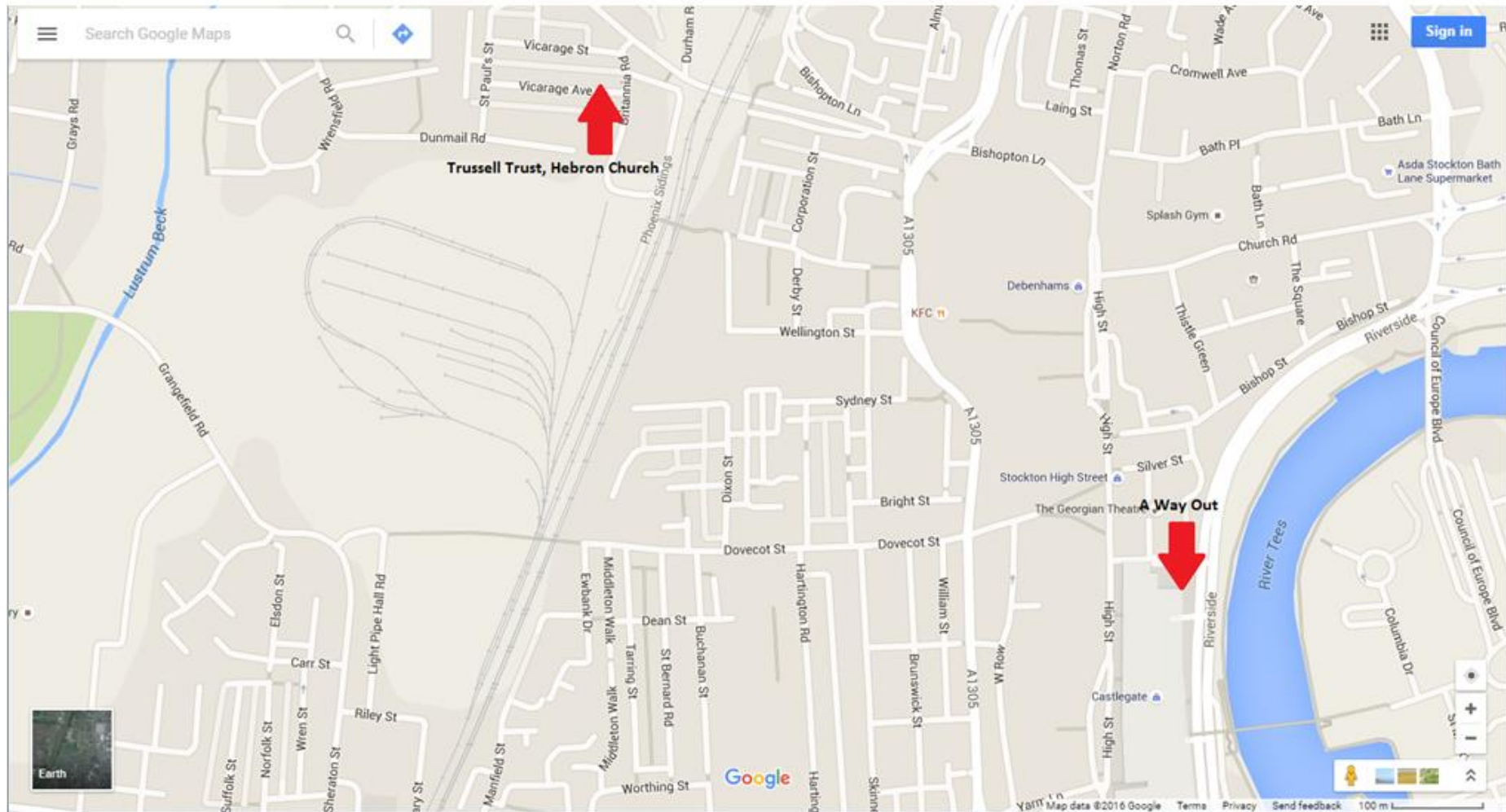

Norton North



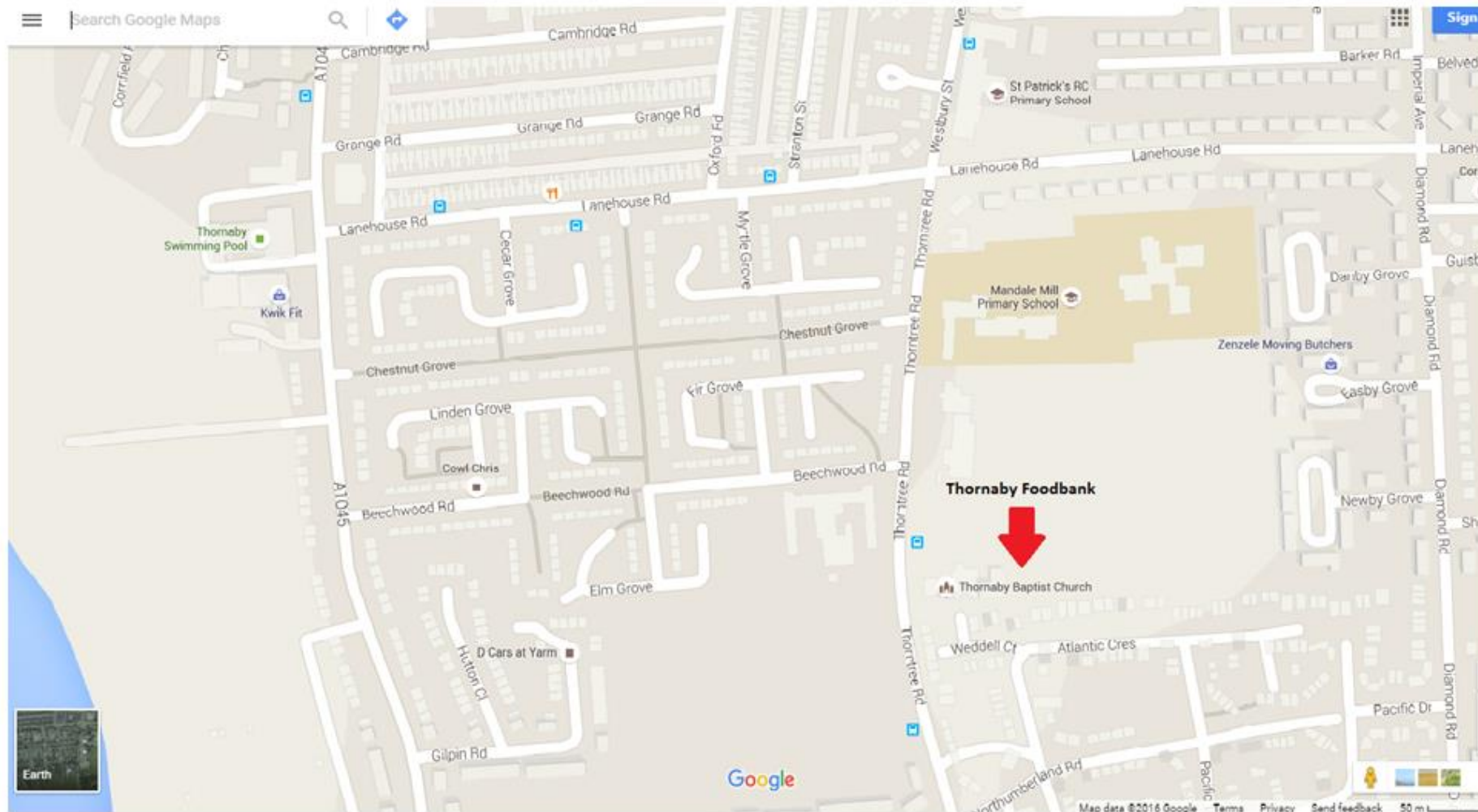
